

Are You EPA Lead Safe Certified?

COMPLIANCE FOR FEDERAL PURPOSES IS MANDATORY FOR ALL CHILD OCCUPIED FACILITIES

This certification is **required** for any trade disturbing a painted surface in a building constructed prior to 1978 and where children **could** be present. The deadline for compliance with the new regulation was April 22, 2010, and is now passed. The rule applies to all **homes, schools, hospitals and churches constructed prior to 1978**. Act now to get your certification.

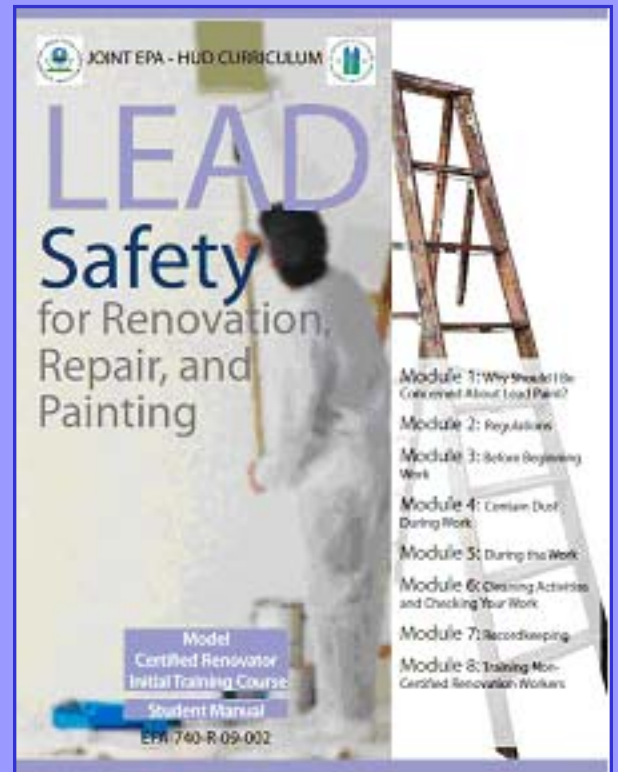
